

Dome-shape baby hat:

Place pattern on the sleeve of a t-shirt. Position bottom of the pattern on the finished hem of the sleeve.

Cut two.

Pin the two pieces with right sides together and sew each side from hem to point using 1/4 inch seam allowance.

Pull the dart open. Match edges. Sew across.

Clip threads and turn right side out.

Most sleeves are large enough to make one hat from each sleeve. If not, cut and open both sleeves.

**Hint: Hats can be cut from other parts of the shirt as well. To sew in the hem, turn up 1/2 inch of the bottom of the hat to the inside and sew a hem using a narrow zigzag.

Top-knot baby hat:

Place pattern on the hemmed edge of the t-shirt.

Cut two.

With right sides together, sew from hem to hem using 1/4 inch seam allowance.

Turn right side out.

Tie a single knot in the top of the hat.

**Hint: Hats can be cut from other parts of the shirt, especially from long sleeves. To sew in the hem, turn up 1/2 inch of the bottom of the hat to the inside and sew using a narrow zigzag.
